



**Declaration of conformity according to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (POP)**  
**Revision 2023-08-28**

The Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) aims to safeguard human health and the environment by enforcing specific measures to eliminate these harmful substances. It mandates the prohibition or restriction of the production, use, import, and export of POPs. In Europe, the Convention is implemented through Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and Council, dated June 20, 2019, on persistent organic pollutants (POP Regulation).

Meyer Sintermetall AG hereby confirms that it does not produce POPs. Furthermore, regular supplier assessments ensure that all substances used in our products comply with relevant regulations

The products manufactured, processed, and distributed by Meyer Sintermetall AG are free from persistent organic pollutants as defined by the current POP Regulation (EU) 2019/1021. However, the supplier statements have not been independently verified through laboratory testing by Meyer Sintermetall AG.
